Guest Speaker:

Dr. Trevor J. Blank '05 American Studies Assistant Professor of Communication, State University of New York at Potsdam

Dr. Blank came to UMBC in fall 2003 as a transfer student from Montgomerv College. Before graduating in spring 2005, he conducted extensive undergraduate research on the folklore, history, and architecture of the Hillcrest Building, an original UMBC building torn down in 2007. The building-the first of its kind-had served as Spring Grove Hospital Center's facility for the containment and rehabilitation of criminally insane patients from 1922-1965. This research on the Hillcrest Building and Spring Grove formed the foundation of Dr. Blank's Master's project and portions of the co-authored publication Spring Grove State Hospital (Arcadia, 2008).

Dr. Blank currently teaches courses in folklore, mass media, and digital culture and researches subversive humor in the vernacular response to traumatic and shocking news events.
